Lies, More Lies, and the Biggest Lie of All

I will not back down on what I said in a recent column. Marxists lie!

The Labour Party of England, a stronghold of Marxism, was exposed for that very thing this past week. I am not at all surprised.

British writer Melanie Phillips [10/26/09] has again distinguished herself by catching the British Labour Party in a lie. The following headline ran in <http://www.dailymail.co.uk/>

The outrageous truth slips out: Labour cynically plotted to transform the entire make-up of Britain without telling us.

What is Phillips talking about? She is informing her readers of a plot to do away with what it is that distinguishes the British from their European neighbors. Self-loathing Marxists, who take no pride in being British, opened the floodgates to millions of immigrants whose culture is and apparently will always remain different from their own.

Labour attempted to introduce into England what is called “multiculturalism” or the idea that every culture is as good as every other. And if that is the case, we have no right to expect that people entering our country fit in with our culture. Those who think like this are denounced as xenophobes, white supremacists, or racist bigots.

Marxists are quick to label others in this way because more often than not they think of themselves as citizens of the world and not citizens of any particular country. Marxism stands for trans-nationalism. The people on the left believe that first of all they belong to the world and not to their country.

Who was behind the plot to deceive the British people and why all the subterfuge? The bigwigs of the Labour Party: Tony Blair, Jack Straw, Gordon Brown, a.k.a. the usual suspects, were all in on it.

In an attempt to *force diversity* down the throats of the British people, and in order to bring into the country those who would vote on behalf of Labour, thus safeguarding a pivotal place in the government for Labour, the Party of the Fabian/Marxists, intentionally misled the British people.

Just this past week a former speech writer for Tony Blair, Andrew Neather, “let the cat out of the bag.” Labour promised to control immigration but instead the British people were subjected to what Neather admitted was “Left-wing bullying.” As a result the United Kingdom was opened to mass immigration.

Responding to the governmental policies, Ms. Phillips says some things that we can relate to in our country.

Such an increase is simply unsustainable. Britain is already one of the most overcrowded countries in Europe. But now look at the real reason why this policy was introduced, and in secret. The Government's 'driving political purpose,' wrote Neather, was 'to make the UK truly multicultural.'

It was therefore a politically motivated attempt by ministers to transform the fundamental make-up and identity of this country. It was done to destroy the right of the British people to live in a society defined by a common history, religion, law, language and traditions.

It was done to destroy for ever what it means to be culturally British and to put another 'multicultural' identity in its place. And it was done without telling or asking the British people whether they wanted their country and their culture to be transformed in this way.

Spitefully, one motivation by Labour ministers was 'to rub the Right's nose in diversity and render their arguments out of date.' [emphasis added]

Alas, America has the same problem as Great Britain - the problem of lying Marxists.

Now on the telephone, we have to press 1 for Spanish and 2 for English. Soon we may have to press 3 for Arabic. I object to this! My people who came here from Greece realized that they should not speak Greek in front of Americans because that was ill-mannered. They had to speak English. Now we have to speak Spanish even though our native tongue is English. What is ironic about all of this is that I really don't think that the Spanish-speaking community objects to speaking English.

The Left has lied in America just as they have in England when it comes to the subject of immigration. They have asked us to believe that they want to grant amnesty to millions of immigrants and their children because they are compassionate. I am not so sure. The people I call Marxists know that immigrants will vote for those who granted them amnesty because they entered this country illegally. **Amnesty thus becomes a form of bribery.**

But why is this important? Mass immigration prevents the host country from being able to assimilate the new arrivals that we have discovered are open to Marxist ideology. In other words, the American culture is worth preserving.

The "surf and soul" Rabbi Nachum Schifren of California has something to say about all of this. His words should be placarded on every school building in America.

Each one of us comes from 'somewhere' . . . My grandparents came from Russia, but there must be a cohesive element that we all buy into for the sake of the whole. Here they are: our constitution, our Bill of Rights, and our English language. These are what makes us Americans, and the loosening of these bonds will eradicate the very glue that that our American forefathers fought and died for.

I have witnessed this process taking place in our schools over the last few decades, unbeknownst to the vast majority of American bread winners, too busy surviving to pay attention. We, Americans, are now made to feel guilty for our culture, our ENGLISH LANGUAGE, our flag, the very bond that sustains and nurtures each of us.
