Tea Party Trouble for Liberals

Under revolutionary socialism only the purblind can fail to grasp the assault on property and the onset of confinements of the population. The brutality of the attack is too blunt and persistent to escape detection by any except those who resolutely will to ignore it. By contrast, evolutionary socialism is intruded in such a way, particularly under long-established parliamentary governments, that its restraints, confinements, and erosions of the ground of liberty and property are not so readily seen.

Taxes

If the Tea Party movement hopes to influence our government's attitude toward burdensome taxes it will have to distance itself from the Neoconservatives, the war party, the party that believes America should police the world. Wars cost money and that means more taxes. That being the case the Tea Party will need to have a sit-down with former Alaskan Governor Sarah Palin who on the eve of tax day was their headline speaker at a massive rally in Boston.

From what I can see Palin is a Neocon. That is more important than her not being intellectually equipped for the presidency as some are saying. If such a law is not abolished immediately it will spread, multiply and develop into a system.
